May The Month of prayer dedicated to Our Lady:

May, traditionally is the month dedicated to prayer to Mary the Mother of God. Let us begin our day by offering all our concerns, joys and thanksgivings to Mary.

Perhaps you would create a May Altar prayer space in your home in honour of Our Blessed Mother and pray the rosary.

Usually a Rosary is recited at the Grotto or in the church on Sunday's during the month of May. Current Covid restrictions which are not lifted until the 10th of May means we cannot do this until Sunday 16th of May at 6pm. All are welcome then.

Act of Spiritual Communion

Sacraments of First Holy Communion

We will be able to celebrate these sacraments in our parish when it is safe to do so. Currently it is advised that First Holy Communions should not take place at this time. We encourage the children and parents to continue to prepare for these special occasions in their lives by prayer at home and using the relevant section in class religion book – Grow in Love.

Lifting of Level 5 Covid 19 Restrictions and what they mean for our faith community: Daily and Weekend Mass

From tomorrow Monday the <u>10th of May</u> **50** are permitted to attend Mass. As with previous reopening for Mass, the following protective measures continue to apply:

- 2m social distancing guidelines adhered to (members of the same household can sit/stand close together)
- Wearing of face coverings
- No congregation by people outside the Church before and after any service
- Seats must be sanitised after each gathering. Your help in this regard would be greatly appreciated. Cloths and sanitiser are provided. If people brought their own wipe and sanitiser with them and looked after the pew they used this would be a great help.
- If possible leave the weekend masses for families who have anniversaries booked.

It is advised that other religious ceremonies such as First Holy Communions and Confirmations should not take place at this time.

From <u>10th May</u> 50 guests permitted at the wedding (civil or religious).

For celebrations/receptions, a maximum of 6 people are permitted for indoor gatherings and 15 people for outdoor gatherings.
