Season of Creation September 1st to October 4th.

After the Season of Creation which runs from 1st September to the 4th of October there will be a UN meeting on Climate Change in November of world leaders in Scotland (known as COP 26) and another UN Conference of world leaders on Biodiversity is scheduled to take place in China during Spring 2022.

In preparation for these UN meetings a petition known as the Healthy Planet, Healthy People Petition which has been endorsed by the Vatican Dicastery for Integral Human Development and is available at http://healthyplanetandpeople.org/ for dioceses, parishes, and individuals to sign. It is envisaged that this petition with signatures will be presented by Pope Francis to the Presidents of the upcoming COP 26 in Glasgow at the beginning of November 2021. COP26 is a critical moment for our common home, and we are urged as Catholics to raise our voices for the most vulnerable and for God's creation by signing and promoting this petition.

Legion of Mary Centenary Celebrations

The 7th of September was the centenary of the founding of the Legion of Mary by Frank Duff, (servant of God). It is an organisation for lay Catholics whose members give service to the church on a voluntary basis. The Legion of Mary is now working in over 170 countries on all continents. It has an active membership of over four million members and five million auxiliary members. The cause for the canonisation of Frank Duff was introduced in 1996; the prayer for his beatification is available on the table at the back of the church.

The Legion of Mary weekly meetings take place in the Pastoral Centre on Tuesday evenings at 7.30pm. New members most welcome.

Ball4all

Oola GAA/LGFA are opening up a new section of the club for children who cannot ordinarily take part in team sports with physical disabilities, neuro diversity (autistic) or children with intellectual disabilities.

This will initially be 4-10 age group with a view to expanding the ages and range of children once we get comfortable with the format. We will be limiting the numbers to 10 or less to begin with, it will be 1:1 adult ratio and we will also be asking parents to assist for the comfort of the children. The session will be fun format games with a view to introducing football skills little by little each week

We have worked with the LGFA, GAA and other clubs who are successfully delivering this programme . We have sought guidance from Limerick sports partnership, Cara sport, The GAA diversity+ inclusion officer, Limerick GAA, GAA games for all, local families living with disabilities and Games development officers.

We have put a team of coaches and helpers together that includes experienced special needs assistants and special education teachers all of whom are committed to being the "one good coach" in these kids life, who are determined to help that child succeed and have fun. All our coaches will be Garda vetted and equipped with suitable equipment.

We are very excited to announce our unique name in Oola GAA+LGFA will be "Ball4all".
