October Rosary

Since the Middle Ages, October has been considered the month of the rosary and it is, just like May, dedicated to Mary, the Mother of God. In the rosary prayer, we pray to Mary and look with her at the life of Jesus. She knew Jesus so well, as only a mother knows her child. The rosary is a meditative prayer. The constant repetition of the same sentences allows you to become completely quiet. This means you can pay attention to what God wants to tell you. We pray with a rosary. The beads of the rosary help us count the prayers. In the rosary we follow the important events of Jesus's life. In what are called the five decades or five mysteries, we look at what Mary experienced with Jesus.

During the month of October The Rosary will be prayed in the church every Sunday evening at 5.00 p.m.
