The initial plan of Ballyhoura Rural Services is to put the school forward to house Ukrainian refugees in order to obtain public funding to upgrade the building for this purpose. While we warmly welcome the initial proposed use of the building we as the community council have serious concerns about the longer term proposed use of the building without community consultation and approval.
