We pray for Pope Leo XIV who will be inaugurated during Mass in the Vatican this Sunday beginning at 9am Irish time. It officially marks the beginning of his papacy. He will receive a gold signet ring specially cast for each new pope, and typically bears the image of Saint Peter. The ring marks both the beginning and end of a papacy - when a pope dies, it is destroyed by the camerlengo, a senior cardinal. He will also be presented with the pallium, a strip of lambswool which represents his role as a shepherd. It is placed on his shoulders before the mass begins.
